Conference Objectives

At the completion of the conference, participants will be able to:

- State a personal goal to attain from the conference.
- Examine theories, models, and frameworks that could be used in healthcare and nursing informatics practice, education, administration, and research domains. Discuss local informatics issues through professional networking and personal problem solving.

- Create and present a brief summary of the workgroup findings and recommendations associated with the assigned case study.
- Distinguish standards and terminologies that affect the information system life cycle.
- Identify 2 strategies used in the assessment phase to identify and collect pertinent data and information.
- Describe available hardware, software, and communications components for a healthcare information management solution.
- Discuss the role of project management, systems analysis and design in planning a successful system implementation
- Develop a test plan, education plan, and project management plan to implement an information system.
- Evaluate the implementation of a healthcare IS solution and methods to communicate the results of the evaluation activities.
- Describe the professional performance activities of an informatics nurse in the lifelong learning cycle.
- Assess readiness to complete the ANCC certification for nursing informatics, describe the initial application and follow-on recertification processes.
- Evaluate WINI and discuss content for future nursing informatics workshops.
